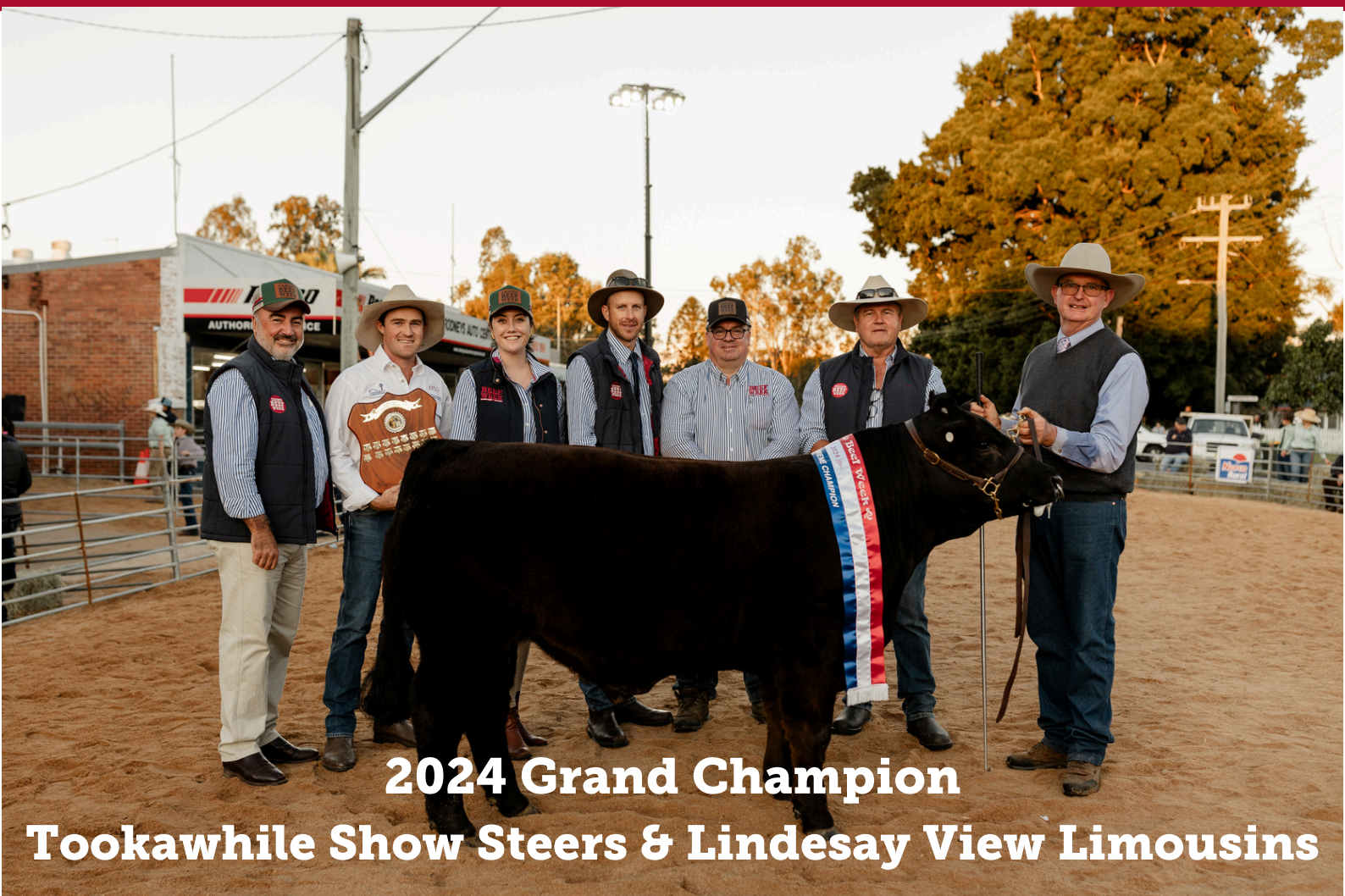

Junior Cattle

Conditions of Entry

1. Entries close Monday, May 12, 2025, at 9 am
2. Entries are open to exhibitors under the age of 18, or entry as a school group
3. The junior exhibitor must prepare a steer/heifer
4. All Led steerers must be MSA Registered. Each vendor will be required to gain MSA producer registration and be accompanied by an MSA v-dec.
5. Led steers/heifers to be presented for weighing and mouthing between the designated times, Wednesday, 28th May 2025
6. The committee reserves the right to reject any entry or inferior steers
7. Nose rings are not to be removed - Steers will be disqualified if nose rings are removed
8. Only polled (no scurs) & cleanly dehorned (not tipped) steers will be accepted in the competition.
9. Fixed nose rings must be used and correctly secured, no grips or clips
10. Carcasses processed at The Casino Food Co-op and judged using the MSA Carcase Competition System.
11. HGP-treated cattle will not be accepted in the led steer events
12. The committee reserve the right to restrict the number of entries per competitor to ensure a high standard of competition
13. Exhibitors must have public liability insurance extended to include attendance at Casino Beef Week. A copy of the Certificate of Currency must accompany the entry form. A minimum cover of \$10 million is required.
14. The National Vendor Declaration (and any other livestock forms that may be required at the time) must be given to the Auctioneer before weighing, not to the Beef Week office. NLIS Tags are required.
15. The exhibitor accepts all risks and liability for any injury, loss or damage, whether or not such damage is caused or contributed to by negligence, omission or acts by the organiser, its agents, its employees, volunteers or others participating in Beef Week.
16. Exhibitors will not, under any circumstances, hold the Casino Beef Week committee responsible for their loss or mis-delivery of livestock, or any damage thereto.
17. Steers and heifers will be sold c/kg carcass weight, not live weight
18. The committee reserves the right to combine or change classes if required
19. The winner of every steer class will be eligible for the champion steer
20. All cattle entered must be killed
21. No refunds on any steers entered
22. All steers must be tired up in the designated area on the saw dust
23. By entering you acknowledge that in the course of the event, photographs, images or film may be taken of yourself, either alone or in group shots with others. Junior and specialty classes (e.g., Returning Steers/Heifers) do not receive points.

Stud Cattle

Conditions of Entry

1. Exhibits must be registered or eligible for registration in their respective Society Herd Book.
2. Entries close Monday, May 12, 2025, at 9 am
3. All ages to be taken from and including 1st May 2025
4. All cattle entered in stud classes must be tractable and must be led into the parade ring. Stewards reserve the right to have any animal removed from the judging ring or other areas, if they think such animal is classed as dangerous, intractable or disadvantaging other exhibits.
5. Stud grooms are required to wear dust coats or breed uniforms. All animals must wear neck cards around their necks or attached to the exhibitor. Cards are to be collected at the scale area.
6. The judge has the right to refuse allocation of prizes.
7. All animals must wear a nose ring or a nose grip and chin chain (bulls over 12 months must be ringed)
8. The committee may split classes if necessary
9. Exhibitors must have public liability insurance that extends to include attendance at Casino Beef Week. To accompany the entry form, photocopy the public liability insurance or a Certificate of Currency. A minimum cover of \$10 million is required.
10. The committee reserves the right to restrict the number of entries
11. All entries are to have neck collars.
12. Cattle in the street must be under the control of the owner or a representative at all times.
13. Cows in the stud beef classes three years and over must be in calf or showing signs of being a breeder.
14. The winner of each class will be eligible for the champion classes.
15. If doubt arises in the mind of the judge(s), in any class, regarding the classification of a competing animal, the matter will be referred to the chief steward for consideration.
16. Attention is drawn to the fact that all calves paraded with their mothers must not be more than 8 months of age
17. All cattle must be made available for inspection at any time to persons nominated by the Beef Week Committee
18. Exhibitors will not, under any circumstances, hold the Casino Beef Week committee for their loss, mis-delivery of livestock, or any damage thereto.
19. Exhibitors should be aware that animals at foot entering a calf class cannot be shown on the dam as a cow and calf unit. Similarly, any animal shown on the dam cannot be entered in the calf class.
20. Stud cattle must be tied up in the designated stud cattle area
21. All bulls to be weighed Saturday morning between 6:30am - 7:00am
22. By entering you acknowledge that in the course of the event, photographs, images or film may be taken of yourself or group shots. You agree to the use of the images or film for use in any of Casino Beef Week's marketing, including but not limited to their websites and publications. You also agree that the photographs or film may be used by third party media organisations in connection with reporting on Casino Beef Week.
23. The Committee reserves the right to change these conditions at any time.
24. Specialty classes are to be entered into alongside their general class.

COMBINED POINTS SYSTEM

Stud Cattle Point System

Points are awarded at the following shows:

- Bonalbo Show
- Maclean Show
- Grafton Show
- Casino Beef Week

Important:

Points are only given in **open classes** – not in junior or specialty classes

Class Placings

- 1st place = 3 points
- 2nd place = 2 points
- 3rd place = 1 point

Champion Awards

Extra points are awarded for champions:

- Junior/Senior Champion = 2 points
- Reserve Champion = 1 point
- Overall Breed Champion = 1 point
- Supreme Champion (if awarded) = 1 point

Example

If an animal places:

- 1st in class = 3 points
- Wins Junior Champion = +2 points
- Wins Overall Breed Champion = +1 point
- Wins Supreme Champion = +1 point
- Total = 7 points
